## DECLARATION 4: IN INDIANA, WE ARE TRAINED AND READY FOR BATTLE

- Psalm 144:1 Praise be to the LORD my Rock, who trains my hands for war, my fingers for battle.
- Psalm 18:34 He trains my hands for battle; my arms can bend a bow of bronze.
- Genesis 14:14 When Abram heard that his relative had been taken captive, he called out the 318 trained men born in his household and went in pursuit as far as Dan. <sup>15</sup> During the night Abram divided his men to attack them and he routed them, pursuing them as far as Hobah, north of Damascus. <sup>16</sup> He recovered all the goods and brought back his relative Lot and his possessions, together with the women and the other people.
- 1 Chronicles 5:18 The Reubenites, the Gadites and the half-tribe of Manasseh had 44,760 men ready for military service—able-bodied men who could handle shield and sword, who could use a bow, and who were trained for battle.
- 2 Chronicles 26:11 Uzziah had a well-trained army, ready to go out by divisions according to their numbers as mustered ... <sup>12</sup> The total number of family leaders over the fighting men was 2,600. <sup>13</sup> Under their command was an army of 307,500 men trained for war, a powerful force to support the king against his enemies.
