This was a serious case: he is "possessed by a spirit" (Lk), that "robbed him of speech" (Mk); has "seizures" and "convulsions" (Mt & Lk), is "suffering greatly" (Mt); "thrown to ground" (Mk), and "often falls into fire and water" (Mt); "foams at the mouth" (Mk & Lk); it "scarcely ever leaves him" (Lk), and it "is destroying him" (Lk). When Jesus asked, "How long has he been like this?" the father answers: "From childhood; it has often thrown him into fire or water to kill him" (Mk).

On an earlier occasion the disciples had been given power over demons:

Mark 6:7 Calling the Twelve to him, he began to send them out two by two and gave them authority over impure spirits. (And see Matthew 10:1)

The 72 had experienced victory over the dark forces:

Luke 10:17 The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name."
