## Biblical words for doubt

- Matthew 14:31 Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you **doubt**?" διστάζω, *distadzo:* waver, be of two minds, have second thoughts
- Matthew 21:21 "Truly I tell you, if you have faith and do not **doubt**, not only can you do what was done to the fig tree, but also you can say to this mountain, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and it will be done." διακρίνω, *diakrino*: differentiate; weighing matters, leads to wavering or hesitation
- James 1:6 But when you ask, you must believe and not **doubt**, because the one who **doubts** is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.
- Luke 24:38 He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds?"
   διαλογισμός, dialogismos: involves a clash of ideas, turning things over in one's mind; "dialogue"
- John 20:27 "Put your finger here; see my hands. Reach out your hand and put it into my side. Stop **doubting** and believe." ἄπιστος, *apistos:* unbelieving, not trusting, lacking in faith
