There are times when we have to say something to make it happen

Mark 11:23 I tell you the truth, <u>if anyone says</u> to this mountain, "Go, throw yourself into the sea," and does not doubt in his heart but believes that <u>what he says</u> will happen, it will be done for him.

Matthew 21:20 When the disciples saw this, they were amazed. "How did the fig tree wither so quickly?" they asked. ²¹ Jesus replied, "Truly I tell you, if you have faith and do not doubt, not only can you do what was done to the fig tree, but also you can <u>say to this mountain</u>, 'Go, throw yourself into the sea,' and it will be done. ²² If you believe, you will receive <u>whatever you ask for</u> in prayer."

Romans 10:9 If you <u>declare with your mouth</u>, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

Matthew 8:16 When evening came, many who were demon-possessed were brought to him, and he drove out the spirits with a word and healed all the sick.

Luke 7:7 That is why I did not even consider myself worthy to come to you. But <u>say the word</u>, and my servant will be healed. ⁸ For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. <u>I tell this one</u>, "Go," and he goes; and that one, "Come," and he comes. <u>I say to my servant</u>, "Do this," and he does it.

Joel 3:10 ... Let the weakling say, "I am strong!"

Matthew 7:7 <u>Ask</u> and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. ⁸ For <u>everyone who asks</u> receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened. And see James 4:2b.

Proverbs 18:21 <u>The tongue has the power of life and death</u>, and those who love it will eat its fruit. Read about the dry bones in *Ezekiel 37*; it was after Ezekiel prophesied over them as instructed by the Lord that they came together, breath entered them, and they came to life
